



Mobile Audio and Videoconferencing solutions for United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) Congo, South Sudan and Ethiopia

The Challenge

The UNDP required a mobile microphone system for conducting meetings for their offices in Congo, South Sudan and Ethiopia. They needed user-friendly equipment that was easy for participants to operate during meetings. The system had to have an option of recording the meetings for documentation purposes.

The Solution

The following equipment was selected for this project:

- Bosch wireless gooseneck microphones with built-in speakers for meeting participants
- 2 units of handheld microphones
- Speakers and amplifier control





- A camera with a small 7" display, for the operator to see and listen to recordings. The camera is mounted on a tripod.
- A DVD/HDD recorder mounted on a mobile rack provided for this project.
- The UNDP in Congo received additionally, an 84-inch touch screen for presentations and videoconference.

Prior to shipping, AV-Huset pre-programmed the equipment and mounted it on a mobile rack. The UNDP personnel in both locations could easily install the system because of the detailed installation and user manual that was included.

The Benefit

- UNDP received an easy-to-use system with microphones for meeting participants and wireless microphones for the audience.
- The equipment provided, i.e. microphones, speakers, camera and screen are easy to operate and this makes the participants in both locations comfortable with holding their meetings.
